Last year, foreign students attending English language courses at local licensed English Language Teaching (ELT) schools totalled 83,610, equivalent to a decrease of 4.0 per cent over 2018.

## Teaching English as a Foreign Language: 2019

The majority of students attending English language courses in Malta came from Italy (18,335), followed by Germany (9,764) and France (8,878). Together these accounted for 44.2 per cent of total students coming to Malta to learn English (Table 2).

The largest share of language students were aged 15 years or less, accounting for 33.3 per cent of the total students following ELT courses. Students aged 50 and over were in the minority and numbered 6,224. Female students outnumbered males, and accounted for 60.1 per cent of the entire ELT student population (Table 3).

July was the busiest month for local licensed ELT schools with 18,457 arrivals, or 22.1 per cent of the annual total. This was followed by June and August with 11.8 and 10.5 per cent of total students arrivals respectively (Table 4).

The most popular course offered by local licensed ELT schools was 'General English: Standard' which was attended by a total of 58,784 students (70.3 per cent) studying during 2019. This was followed by the 'Intensive English' course, with 15.9 per cent of total students (Table 5).

The share of foreign students attending English language courses in 2019 when compared to total inbound tourists for the same year, stood at 3.0 per cent. Of this share, 2.4 per cent were males and 3.6 per cent were females (Table 6).

Foreign students enrolled in local licensed ELT schools spent a total of 237,066 weeks in Malta. The average length of stay during the year under review stood at 2.8 weeks, an increase of 0.3 of a week when compared to 2018 (Table 8). With an average of 12.4 weeks, students from Colombia recorded the highest average duration. These were followed by South Korean and Chinese students with an average duration of 9.5 and 7.4 weeks respectively (Table 10).

In 2019, the number of staff in local licensed ELT schools stood at 1,796. The largest share of teaching staff (31.9 per cent) was aged between 18 and 24. Female teachers accounted for 72.6 per cent of the total teaching staff (Table 11). Non-teaching staff amounted to 766, of which 57.4 per cent were employed on a full-time basis (Tables 12) ■

Chart 1. Foreign students following courses in local licensed ELT schools by top 10 countries of citizenship: 2019




Chart 3. Foreign students following courses in local licensed ELT schools by age group and sex: 2019









Chart 7. Percentage distribution of teaching staff in local licensed ELT schools by sex and type of employment: 2019





Chart 8. Percentage distribution of non-teaching staff in local licensed ELT schools by sex and type of employment: 2019



## **Methodological Notes:**

- 1. Data used in this News Release is based on information collected by the Ministry for Education and Employment which was subsequently analysed by NSO.
- 2. All local licensed English Language Teaching (ELT) schools operating in 2019 responded to this questionnaire.
- 3. Breakdowns by country are based on the students' citizenship as provided by the student. Thus, figures for foreign citizens are not directly comparable to other tourism figures published by the NSO.
- 4. Only students arriving during the respective reference year are considered in this news release.
- 5. Persons employed with different schools carrying out the same role are counted once in this news release.
- 6. Figures on type of course followed and type of accommodation cannot be compared with data of previous years due to methodological enhancements held for the year 2019.
- 7. References to this news release are to be cited appropriately.
