DESIGN AND DELIVERY OF CPD SESSIONS

The ELT Council is launching this expression of interest intended to offer CPD sessions to ELT educators in the first quarter of 2024.

As per Legal Notice 221 of 2015, trainers must be in possession of the following:

An international diploma at post-graduate level at National Qualifications Framework level 7 or a comparable or higher qualification in ELT from a recognised university or institution plus a minimum of 1,500 ELT contact hours spread over no less than twelve cumulative months;
or

A first degree in English or in English as a main subject at National Qualifications Framework level 6 and an international certificate at National Qualifications Framework level 5, or a comparable or higher qualification in ELT from a recognised university or institution plus a minimum of 2,000 ELT contact hours spread over no less than twelve cumulative months;

and

have at least two years' experience in planning, designing and running ELT related training sessions.

Priority Areas:

- Young learners' language education;
- New modes of professional development in ELT;
- Assessment for learning;
- Train the trainer courses;
- ELT management and leadership;
- Teachers' digital literacy;
- Using psychology in the ELT classroom;
- The development of global skills.

This Expression of Interest is also open for individuals who are interested to deliver CPD sessions in other relevant areas to the personal and professional development of the individual. These may include amongst others:

- Mental health

- Wellbeing
- Health and safety
- Leadership and management
